



The Programme

The Innovation Fellowship programme was created in collaboration with the Royal College of Arts.

It is a deep dive programme where senior corporate innovators are enabled to develop their own Open Innovation strategies, informed and validated by industry experts.

It enables senior-level peer group support, knowledge exchange and reviews global best practice.

We have three intakes a year with up to 16 Fellows in each group.

The programme takes place across three months:

- Six bi-weekly sessions.
- Modular content.
- Small group project work.
- Peer-to-peer learning.



- Available to attend six in-person sessions (three hours each during workdays) over the three-month fellowship.










